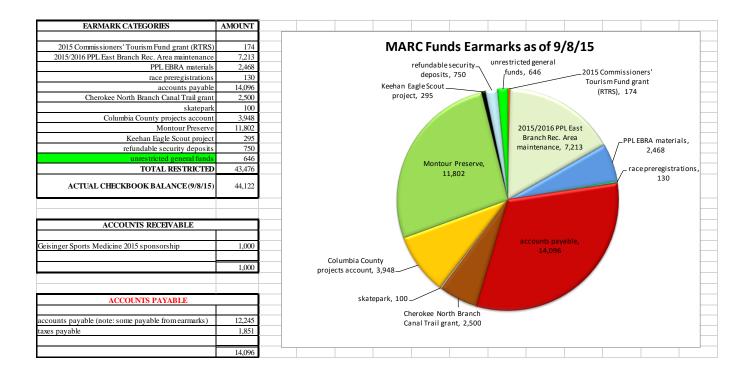

- Montour County Commissioners' 2015 Tourism Fund grant
 - o \$15,000 received on 1/5/15 for 2015 River Towns Race Series advertising and promotion
 - \$174.37 remains earmarked for Sept. Dec. advertising
- Merck Cherokee donation
 - MARC received \$2,500 on 11/17/14 to be used solely for North Branch Canal Trail expenses;
 no funds have been expended to date
 - o all funds will be expended this month for trail construction, signage materials and installation
- Susquehanna Greenway 2014 Mini-Grant Program
 - Trail mileage, caution and misc. signage has been designed, ordered and received; installation will occur in coming weeks
 - o Trailhead kiosks are scheduled for delivery on 9/25
 - o Expense reimbursement request will be submitted this month
- Williams Transco Pipeline Atlantic Sunrise Project / The Conservation Fund Environmental Stewardship Program (no change since last meeting)
 - In partnership with the Susquehanna Greenway Partnership, Stoudt submitted a grant proposal on 1/30 for North Branch Canal Trail construction between Danville, Catawissa and Bloomsburg
 - Total requested grant funding \$491,000 for 2015 2017 (grant did not require local match)
 - \$146,000 grant award announced in June, but funds and grant documentation not yet received; funds will be processed through the Susquehanna Greenway Partnership

PROJECTS/MANAGED SITES

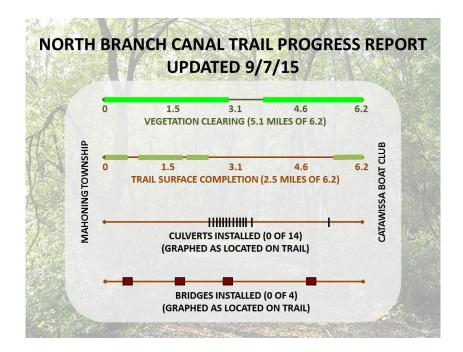
- PPL East Branch Recreation Area
 - Soccer use has increased substantially this summer and is expected to remain steady for the foreseeable future; the purchase of an additional set of goals is expected next spring
 - o \$7,213.13 remains earmarked in our account for site maintenance through April 30, 2016
 - \$2,467.78 remains earmarked in our account for EBRA supplies
- River Road parcel (North Branch Canal Trail trailhead and river access; no change since last meeting)
 - o Property is being managed as part of MARC's mowing contract
 - Stoudt will do site enhancements in coming months as schedule permits
 - An Eagle Scout candidate has completed the creation of a trailhead sign and two ADAcompliant picnic tables for this site
 - materials are being stored in the pig barn until we can install
 - Stoudt will work with Mahoning Township to secure necessary permits

PROJECTS/MANAGED SITES (continued)

- Hess Recreation Area
 - Skatepark (no change since last meeting)
 - \$100 remains earmarked in our account for the project, specifically earmarked for reconstruction of the central pyramidal feature
 - Concrete cracks need to be sealed before they become worse
 - Ballfields (no change since last meeting)
 - Softball field needs two loads of infield mix (estimated cost \$1,000); Stoudt expects to order in early fall, funding permitting
 - Portions of the field turf will be seeded when weather conditions permit
 - Road (no change since last meeting)
 - MARC should consider a chip & tar coating of the road in 2015 to extend the road's expected useful life; cost estimates will have to be sought when funding allows
 - Other
 - Construction of the Valley Township sewer line connector to the Danville sewage treatment plant is now underway; the Old Reading Line Trail (along PA-54) will remain closed until construction is complete
 - restored trail will be 8ft wide gravel surface
 - All repairs to the wetland blind entrance are complete
 - Black bear sightings have been reported occasionally in the park this summer; Stoudt will continue to monitor the situation and will institute trail closures and/or contact the PA Game Commission if deemed necessary
- Hopewell Park / Danville Borough Farm
 - o September 19 women's mountain bike skills clinic has been canceled
 - Dave Decoteau and trail volunteers have worked in recent weeks to improve existing trails and finish planned connections; work will conclude by late September (before hunting seasons)
 - Stoudt/Beam will do additional park/trail maintenance in coming weeks, including replacement of the tire culvert
- Montour Preserve
 - \$118,064.55 raised to date from 197 donors (includes anticipated \$10,000 from Montour County Tourism Fund and Act 13 funds)

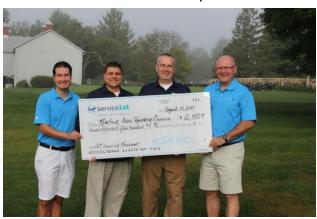

TRAIL OVERVIEW

The Danville to Catawissa portion of the North Branch Canal Trail is being constructed as a semi-natural pathway for pedestrians and bicyclists. Because the trail corridor passes through a number of sensitive natural areas, great care is being taken to minimize the environmental impact of the trail. The trail surface is mowed grass, with an average width of 5ft, though the trail will be narrower in places where necessary to protect natural resources. This trail is not suitable for those with mobility restrictions. The first 0.4 mile-long segment of the 6.2 mile-long trail is being opened in October 2015. Additional trail segments will be opened when bridge and culvert installation is complete.
