

Montour Area Recreation Commission 2017 Lawn Care Invitation to Bid Application Terms and Conditions

Sealed bids for lawn care at the various properties managed by the Montour Area Recreation Commission (MARC) will be received by MARC at any time until Monday, January 9, 2017 at 7:00pm, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud during MARC's regular meeting in the Montour Preserve Environmental Education Center, 700 Preserve Rd, Danville, PA 17821.

Each bid shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope, plainly marked with '**2017 Lawn Care Bid**', and mailed via the U.S. Postal Service to MARC at the address listed above. Sealed bids may also be hand-delivered to MARC between 6:30pm and 6:59pm at the Montour Preserve Environmental Education Center before the January 9th meeting. Bids may be withdrawn by bidders for any reason for a period of forty-eight (48) hours after the time of bid opening. After forty-eight (48) hours from bid opening, bids may not be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days.

A certified Treasurer's Check, a Cashier's Check or a Bid Bond secured by a Corporate Surety approved by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in the amount of ten (10) percent of the entire bid amount must accompany the bid. Or, the successful bidder may furnish a Performance Bond in the amount of the Contract as awarded as security for the faithful performance of the Contract as awarded as payment of all persons, firms or corporations to whom the Contractor may become legally indebted in performing the work. A corporate surety approved to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall issue said bonds. In lieu of a Performance Bond, MARC will accept an irrevocable letter of credit or cash escrow in the amount of the Contract as awarded.

The successful bidder shall be required to furnish to MARC insurance certificates evidencing General Liability Insurance coverage, Automobile Insurance coverage and Workers' Compensation Insurance coverage. Evidence of said insurance coverage shall be required at the time of bid submittal. The successful bidder shall also be required to sign an unconditional waiver of mechanics' and materialmen's liens against Montour, LLC (c/o Real Estate Services, 835 Hamilton St, PL6, Suite 150, Allentown, PA 18101). Waivers shall be filed by MARC in the office of the Prothonotary of Montour County, Pennsylvania.

Any exceptions to these specifications must be so noted. Bids must be submitted on the official proposal form enclosed with this packet. All line items must be completed and no other marks are to be made thereon. All proposals must be signed. MARC reserved the right to accept or reject any and all bids in part, or in full, and to waive any defect or informalities in the bid procedure in part, or in full, and to award the contract in the best interest of MARC.



GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The contract term will extend from April 1, 2017 to November 15, 2017, unless otherwise noted.
- 2. Mowing services will be provided no more than one (1) time per week at each location unless MARC authorizes a revision to this schedule. MARC reserves the right to reduce the total cuts per season depending on weather or other conditions. Weed control will be provided as needed on the areas defined in the bid sheet document as determined and authorized by MARC.
- 3. The contractor shall supply all necessary labor, equipment and materials except as noted in this document. Submitted with bid will be a list of equipment that the contractor will use for this work. This equipment shall be available for inspection at the request of MARC.
- 4. The contractor shall mow athletic fields only on weekdays between the hours of 7:00am and 3:00pm. Properties other than athletic fields may be mowed at other times as needed. Any questions or concerns by field users should be directed to MARC at (570) 336-2060.
- 5. Contractor shall remove harmful objects such as glass bottles or other litter from the path of mowing equipment. Contractor is to notify MARC in the event that litter becomes excessive to the point of being outside the normal scope of work.
- 6. The contractor will trim around all site amenities/ improvements, including but not limited to, fencing, benches, signs, dugouts, planters, paths and trash receptacles. Weed control spray can only be used at the Hess Recreation Area and East Branch Recreation Area as specified on pages 6 and 8 of this document.
- 7. Mechanical trimmers must not be used to control weeds around tree bases unless special approval is granted by MARC.
- 8. Contractor shall be responsible for, and shall restore at his/her expense, all damage to the property caused by the Contractor in the performance of the work which was not reasonably foreseeable as a consequence of the Contractor's performance of this contract.
- 9. Contractor or subcontractors must be a Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection licensed pesticide applicator. Proof of license must be provided at the time of bid submittal. All spraying will be performed in compliance with state regulations.
- 10. Proof of required insurance coverage as outlined in this bid specification must be submitted to MARC prior to the start of the contract term.
- 11. A performance bond or accepted substitute meeting the terms specified on "Invitation to Bid" must be submitted to MARC prior to the start of the contract term.
- 12. Contractor will submit three contract names of references with bid.



GENERAL CONDITIONS (continued)

- 13. All subcontractors needed to complete the specifications of the contract must be listed on the signature page of this bid document. Subcontractors are subject to the same rules and conditions as the primary contractor.
- 14. Only fully completed bid applications will be accepted. MARC reserves the right to reject any partial applications.
- 15. Contractor shall invoice MARC monthly for services rendered. Such invoices shall clearly identify the dates of service, location(s) serviced and the cost per location.



INSURANCE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Contractor (and subcontractors if applicable) shall, at his/her own cost and expense, purchase and maintain in force for the duration of the contract the forms of insurance coverage described hereafter. Subcontractors must produce the same certificates and policies as required of prime contractors, or the prime contractors must submit copies of all policies to which must be attached endorsements indicating that the prime contractor's insurance policy covers the subcontractors to the full extent required by the contracts. Such insurance shall be carried with financially responsible insurance companies, licensed to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.


- A. <u>General Liability Insurance</u> Coverage with a minimum limit of liability per occurrence of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for bodily injury and one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) for property damage. This insurance shall indicate on the certificate of insurance coverage for Independent Contractors and Subcontractors. The Montour Area Recreation Commission (PO Box 456, Danville, PA 17821) and Montour, LLC (c/o Real Estate Services, 835 Hamilton St, PL6, Suite 150, Allentown, PA 18101) shall be added as Additional Insured Parties.
- B. <u>Automobile Liability Insurance</u> Coverage with a minimum limit of liability per occurrence of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for bodily injury and one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) for property damage.
- C. <u>Workers Compensation Insurance Statutory</u> Provision of workers' compensation insurance in compliance with the Workmen's Compensation Act of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Before beginning work, the contractor shall also be required to sign an unconditional waiver of mechanics' and materialmen's liens against Montour, LLC (c/o Real Estate Services, 835 Hamilton St, PL6, Suite 150, Allentown, PA 18101). Waivers shall be filed by MARC in the office of the Prothonotary of Montour County, Pennsylvania.

If, at any time, any of the foregoing policies become unsatisfactory to MARC, as to form or substance, the Contractor shall, upon notice to that effect from MARC, obtain a new policy and submit the same for approval to MARC. Upon failure of the contractor to furnish, deliver and maintain such insurance as provided above, this contract, at the discretion of MARC, may be forthwith declared suspended, discontinued or terminated. Failure of the contractor to take out and/or maintain, or the taking of and or maintenance of any required insurance, shall not relieve the contractor from any liability under this contract, nor shall the insurance requirements be construed to conflict with or otherwise limit the obligations of the contractor concerning indemnification.



SITE 1 - HESS RECREATION AREA Meadow Lane, Danville, PA 17821



We propose to furnish lawn care services for the Hess Recreation Area per your specifications as follows:

<u>Area 1 – Athletic fields and common ground</u> Description: Open field areas in main athletic complex (10.5 acres +/-)

SITE 1 - HESS RECREATION AREA (cont'd)

Trimming

Description: weed-whacking, brush-hog or similar trimming of vegetation along trails and in locations not suitable for regular mowing

- (1) Area around main park entrance gate, kiosk, garden and trees
- (2) Mahoning Flats trail, from trailhead parking lot to roughly 200 yards north of the 'Meditation Meadow' pergola (total length 1,600ft; average width 5ft)
- (3) Area around Beaver Place trailhead parking area, kiosk and bench

<u>SITE 3 – RIVER DRIVE TRAILHEAD PARCEL</u> River Drive, Danville, PA 17821



We propose to furnish mowing services for the River Drive Trailhead parcel per your specifications as follows:

Mowing (brush-hog)

Lot is vacant land with numerous trees and obstacles (2.5 acres +/-). Site is being transformed into a trailhead parking area. Many obstacles exist on the site. Contractor will likely need to use a brush-hog type mower to maintain this site.

We propose to furnish mowing services for Hopewell Park according to your specifications as follows:

2.4 acres +/- of park common areas. Some trees and other features exist.

<u>SITE 5 – NORTH BRANCH CANAL TRAIL</u> River Drive, Danville to Legion Road, Catawissa

NOTE TO BIDDERS: As of this writing, a portion of this 6.2 mile-long trail, between mile markers 3.5 and 4.0, is closed. It is unknown when this section of trail will reopen. As a result, the contractor will have to mow the trail in two sections (3.5 miles and 2.2 miles) from two different access points.

The average trail width is 60 inches, though some portions of the trail are narrower. **Bidders are** strongly cautioned that hazardous conditions exist along this trail, including steep slopes, uneven surfaces, water and other hazards. Unless otherwise approved by MARC, the contractor must use not more than a 40 inch-wide walk-behind (not riding) mower for this site.



We propose to furnish mowing services for the North Branch Canal Trail property per your specifications as follows:

Mowing

6.2 miles +/- of trail.

<u>SITE 6 – MONTOUR TOWNSHIP PARCEL</u> 208 Legion Rd, Catawissa, PA 17820



MARC is responsible for mowing of the vacant parcel located at 208 Legion Road, Catawissa, PA 17820. The parcel is owned by Montour Township (Columbia County). This parcel is used for maintenance access to the North Branch Canal Trail.

We propose to furnish mowing services for the Montour Township parcel per your specifications as follows:

0.8 acres +/- of rough grass. Some trees and other features exist.



We propose to furnish mowing services for the Montour Preserve per your specifications as follows:













