## 3. Robbins Run 5K & 10K - On Deck! June 7th, 2014

No rest for the weary! The Robbins run is less than a month away (hard to believe we used to do these races every two weeks).



#### Here are how the numbers stack-up so far:

In 2013 we had 37 registrants on this date, and ultimately we had 100 online registrations and 239 overall registrations by race day.

If those numbers hold true, we are inline to have 141 online registrations and 336 racers overall.

Attendance predictions/benchmarks have been set at levels equal to 2013 attendance. This means that if all things remain equal and at their present pace, this race too will surpass the predicted attendance levels

### 4. River Towns Cycling Classic

This race will be receiving the lion's share of my time from now until race day.

Due to the marathon and Robbins run, I've done little since last meeting on this race. However, I have scheduled a conference with the sanctioning body, that I hope is very fruitful and I will report on that conversation at our next meeting.

#### THINGS REMAINING TO DO BEFORE OPENING REGISTRATION:

A. Get a very firm grip on how many officials are needed for the sanctioned races, and how much that might cost the event. *Change since last meeting: Conference scheduled.* 

B. Learn and understand Bike Reg as our new online registration client. <u>active.com</u> is stretched to the limit by this kind of festival event. Apparently <u>BikeReg.com</u> is more friendly to festival events once the organizer is familiar with the interface. *Change since last meeting: none.* 

C. Build trails at Hopewell Park - It's real hard to open registration for a mountain bike race, when the venue is very rough at this point. We can get it done, but in the spring rush of the Humdinger and then the Marathon, it's hard to find extra time. It's just a little unsettling in my mind to open registration without a complete venue. *Change since last meeting: some trails have been marked, and others are under construction. Large scale work days will be scheduled very soon. I will be calling on each of you to help.* 

Many other thing are already done, for example the website, we have shops and manufacturer demo truck arranged. Volunteers have been found. Electronic live feeds are arranged. But the details of the routes and sanctioning remain daunting but will be done by the next meeting.

Fortunately, Cyclists are notoriously late to register for events. This is maybe the only instance in my history that I would call that a blessing.
