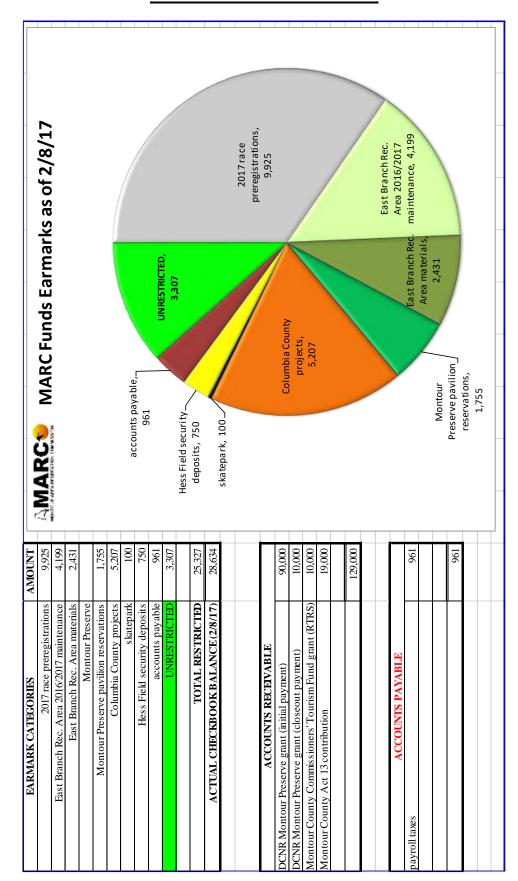

GRANTS

Montour County Commissioners' 2017 Tourism Fund grant application

- o Application submitted 1/19/17 for \$10,000 to support 2017 River Towns Race Series advertising and promotion
- Application approved by Montour County Commissioners on 1/24; forwarded to Columbia Montour Visitors Bureau for consideration
- Columbia Montour Visitors Bureau decision anticipated 2/8

• DCNR 'Other Parks' Grant (Montour Preserve)

- o Preliminary paperwork approved
- o Final grant agreement and request for initial payment to be submitted 2/9
 - \$90,000 in funding anticipated within 2-3 weeks
 - Final \$10,000 payment will be released to MARC upon successful completion of the year-end performance audit

MANAGED SITES

• East Branch Recreation Area

- o As of 2/8/17, \$2,430.66 remains earmarked in MARC's account for site supplies
- o As of 2/8/17, \$4,198.94 remains earmarked in MARC's account for site maintenance through 4/30/17
- o Site maintenance continues to be uneventful; facility usage has been relatively light

• River Drive parcel (North Branch Canal Trail trailhead and river access) (no change since last meeting)

- o Additional site enhancements will be done in coming months as schedule and funding permits
- North Branch Canal Trail (no change since last meeting)
 - o Trail miles 0.0 through 3.5 are open for public use
 - o Trail miles 3.5 − 3.9 remain closed due to adjacent landowner conflict, pending guidance from Montour County
 - \circ Trail miles 3.9 6.2 in Columbia County remain closed until land transfer is complete

• Hopewell Park / Danville Borough Farm

- The orienteering course designed and installed by Eagle Scout Goody McCormick of Boy Scout Troop 50 in Buckhorn is now complete; mapping has been added to MARC's website (copy provided on page 19 of this agenda packet)
- New trail signage is being designed for installation by a likely Eagle Scout candidate, anticipated spring/summer 2017
- o bike jumps/skills area proposal to be considered as part of this meeting's agenda (see page 17)

• Montour Township (Columbia County) parcel

No concerns have been noted

Hess Recreation Area

- Skatepark (no change since last meeting)
 - Concrete cracks need to be sealed before they become worse
- o Ballfields (no change since last meeting)
 - MARC staff have purchased materials to repair the softball field 1st base dugout, anticipated February/March
 - Stoudt anticipates purchasing and installing a load of infield mix when weather conditions allow, anticipated early March
- Parking lot
 - At least two loads of stone will be needed this spring to repair extensive potholes throughout the parking lot (estimated materials cost \$700 with additional approximately \$200 MARC labor and approximately \$100 trailer rental to transport Stoudt's tractor to the site)
- o Road (no change since last meeting)
 - Stoudt has gotten contact information for several other possible contractors to seek estimates;
 information will be provided to Danville Borough when received

Montour Preserve

- o Maple sugaring open houses are scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 25 and Sunday, March 5
 - several school group visits have also been scheduled during week days
- The 1/28 1/29 Wildlife Art Show proved to be a successful event
 - eight artists planned to attend, but three had to cancel due to illness
 - approximately 200 visitors attended the two-day event
 - \$131 in donations received during the event
 - next show scheduled for November 11 & 12, 2017
- MARC staff continue to take down a significant number of dead ash trees along road and trail corridors, though a large number of trees remain to be cut; work will be ongoing through the winter and early spring
- o Site usage remains light during recent weeks; winter hours remain in effect for the visitors' center
- As of 12/31/16, MARC has so far raised \$419,063.68 in donations and pledges for the Montour Preserve

- Volunteers are needed to assist with setup of the Humdinger Trail Races during the week of 2/26 –
 3/3; volunteers are also needed to assist with day-of-race operations on Saturday, March 4
- o MARC's insurance policy for River Towns Race Series races has been modified to allow for a January renewal of the policy; this will allow for more timely submission of PennDOT and local municipal permits, particularly for the River Towns Half-Marathon
- o As of 2/8, 2017 River Towns Race Series registrations include:
 - Humdinger: 235 (300 cap; anticipating sell-out)
 - River Towns Half-Marathon: 96 (500 cap; not anticipating sell-out)
 - Scale the Trail 4 Kids (registration not yet open)
 - Old Forge Brewing Company Beer Run (registration not yet open)
 - Montour 24 Endurance Runs:151 (260 cap; some categories already sold out)

 - Chilli Challenge (registration not yet open)

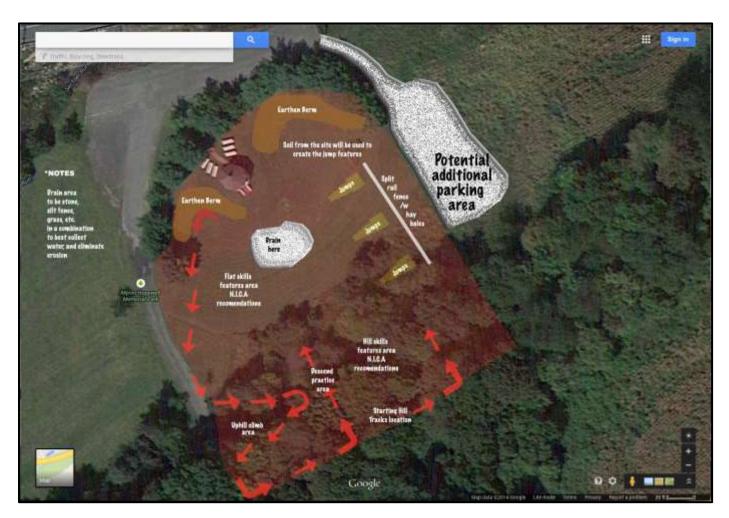

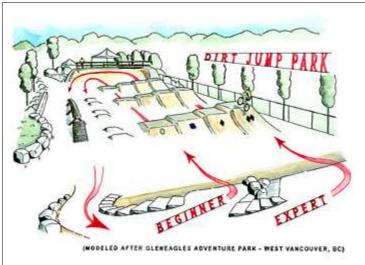

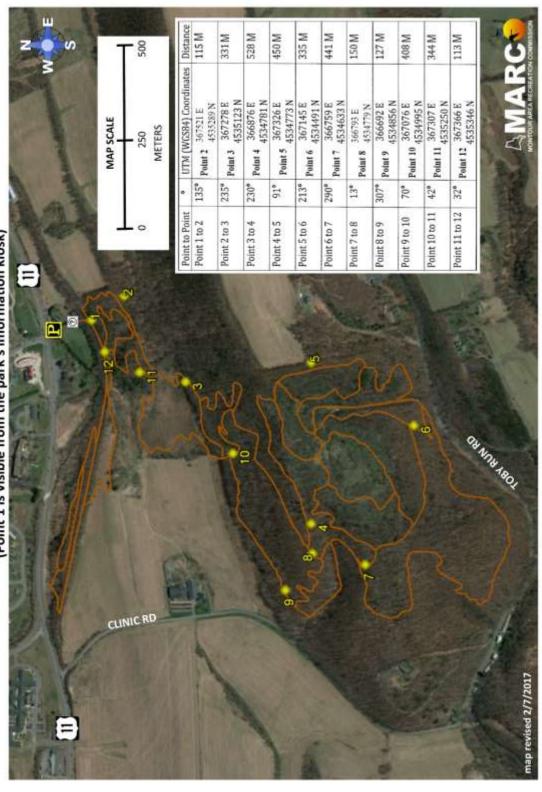
