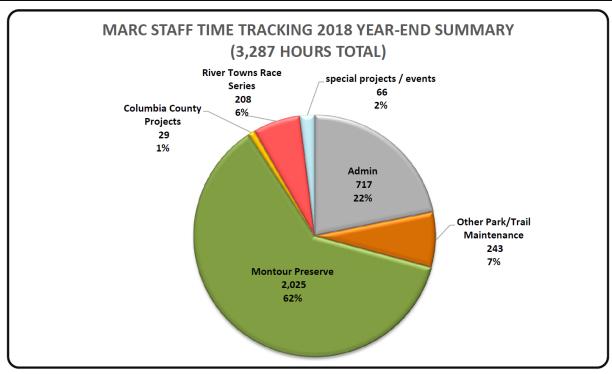
DIRECTOR'S REPORT

- For reference, MARC staff worked a total of 3,669 hours in 2017. Differences include:
 - o 302 fewer hours worked in 2018 on River Towns Race Series races
 - o 22 fewer hours worked in 2018 on special projects and events
 - o 26 more hours worked in 2018 at the Montour Preserve
 - o 58 fewer hours worked in 2018 on other park & trail maintenance
 - o 14 fewer hours worked in 2018 on admin
 - o 12 fewer hours worked in 2018 on Columbia County projects



GRANTS

• DCNR 'Heritage and Other Parks' Grant (Montour Preserve)

- \circ Initial \$100,000 grant has been twice amended to a total of \$300,000 and extended through 6/30/2019
 - most recent \$90,000 disbursement received and deposited to MARC's savings account on 11/29/18
 - \$30,000 (10% of total grant amount) will remain held by DCNR until the successful completion of the performance audit at the end of the grant term

• Montour County Commissioners' 2018 Act 13 (Marcellus Legacy Fund) Grants

- o \$25,000 (\$7,500 and \$17,500) received from Montour County in 2018 were expended in 2018 to help fund MARC's general operations and site maintenance
- o Grant is complete as of 12/31/18 and will not appear in future Director's Reports

• 2018 Montour County Commissioners' Tourism Fund Grant – River Towns Race Series

- o \$6.80 remained earmarked in MARC's general checking account on 12/31/18
- o all funds have been expended as of 1/24/19
- o Grant is complete as of 1/24/19 and will not appear in future Director's Reports

2018 Montour County Commissioners' Tourism Fund Grant – Signage

- o \$2,000 received and deposited to MARC's general checking account on 3/9
- o All grant funds have been expended
- o All signage has been installed as of 9/30
- o Grant is complete as of 12/31/18 and will not appear in future Director's Reports

Youth in Philanthropy grant

- o MARC applied, on behalf of the Central Susquehanna Hammers Interscholastic Mountain Biking Team, for \$3,000 in grant funding for 2018 operational support for the team
- o \$1.000 was awarded to MARC on 5/2
- \$1,000 on 5/21 was passed through to the Danville Area School District Outdoor and Trails Club for use by the team
- Year-end grant closeout report was submitted as required by December 1
- o Grant is complete as of 12/31/18 and will not appear in future Director's Reports



MANAGED SITES

- River Drive parcel (North Branch Canal Trail trailhead and river access)
 - No change since last meeting
- Montour Township (Columbia County) Legion Road parcel
 - No change since last meeting
- Riverside Borough river access (NO CHANGE SINCE LAST MEETING)
 - o River levels have remained consistently too high to allow work on the sign that it out of alignment
 - Stoudt will attempt the work once river levels have gone down and soil has dried out

• Hopewell Park / Danville Borough Farm

- Stoudt met with the Montour County Conservation District on 1/23 to discuss options to improve the drainage from the bike jumps / pump track area; frequent heavy rains have made the site and adjacent parking lot chronically muddy
 - Stoudt will work with Dave Decoteau and others to consider alternatives and will pursue permits as might be required to do the work
- A break-in at the pig barn was discovered on 11/27 by former MARC Board member Dave Walker and reported to Stoudt
 - Stoudt inspected the building and contacted the Mahoning Township Police Department to document and report the incident
 - the following items, valued at a combined total of \$2,175, were stolen from the building:
 - 30 ten-foot long 1 3/4" diameter galvanized steel pipes
 - 80 five-foot long 1 1/4" diameter galvanized steel pipes
 - 3 fifty-foot long, five-light work light strings
 - the vandal(s) broke into the building by cutting and breaking a steel eye bolt which held the door lock and chain; they also broke a number of windows throughout the building and scattered materials
 - Stoudt, Piatt and Yeich repaired and cleaned up the building during the week of 12/3 12/7 at a total cost for labor and materials of roughly \$1,000
 - Stoudt has posted trail cameras around the building and has documented three additional attempted breaking and entering incidents, as well as one vandalism incident
 - audio and video recordings have been provided to Mahoning Township Police, as well as to Danville Borough Police and Danville Borough staff
 - investigations are ongoing as of 1/24



MANAGED SITES (continued)

Hess Recreation Area

- o An area of hillside approximately 40ft wide by 20ft high slid onto the Robbins Trail on 11/27/18
 - The slide appears to have been caused by the long-term supersaturated conditions at the site, made worse by freezing and thawing of the hillside and the ongoing die-off and collapse of hemlock and ash trees
 - Stoudt, Piatt, Yeich and Joe Ward cleared a significant portion of the slide on 11/30, but did not have large enough machinery to complete the work
 - Stoudt employed Elijah Evans Excavating to clear the remaining debris from the trail on 12/11 at a cost of \$900
 - Stoudt continues to monitor several other developing slides in the same immediate area, including two portions of the Robbins Trail itself
 - Stoudt met on 1/23 with the Montour County Conservation District to consider options to stabilize the site
 - o MARC would likely need to hire a geotechnical engineering firm to analyze the site and design a solution to stabilize the hillside
 - o the engineering work alone is estimated in the several thousand dollars range; the cost to adequately stabilize the hillside is estimated at more than \$100,000
 - MARC has no funding available to undertake such a project; Stoudt will
 continue to monitor conditions at the site and will close the trail for the short
 or long-term if conditions warrant
- Conditions remain too wet to allow repair of damages to a trail bridge and boardwalk along the Mahoning Flats Trail network
 - Stoudt will coordinate repairs when soil conditions allow, perhaps with the assistance of an Eagle Scout candidate









MANAGED SITES (continued)

North Branch Canal Trail

- The large pile of straw bales placed near mile marker 1.7 has been mostly removed, though some bales remain
- o Utility workers working near mile marker 1.4 have caused minor damages to the trail
- Trail Steward Wayne Kashner continues to monitor the trail and has reported several new erosion concerns since the recent high water events
 - A portion of the river bank near mile marker 4.9 suffered significant erosion during the 2018 flooding events and may eventually threaten the trail
 - Stoudt, Trail Steward Wayne Kashner and representatives of Columbia County and the Columbia County Conservation District visited the site on 11/27 to inspect the site and determine whether any corrective action might be possible; discussions are ongoing
- \circ Most of the trail in Montour Township, Columbia County, between mile markers 5.7 6.2, has been partly or fully inundated with water since late summer 2018
- o No work has yet been attempted near the campground because of continued wet conditions
 - Stoudt will follow up again as soon as conditions allow
 - Stoudt has consulted with the Montour County Conservation District regarding allowable repairs

• Montour Preserve

- Lights around the Environmental Education Center parking lot were noticed to not be working in mid-November
 - Stoudt and Piatt have investigated and discovered at least one burned-out wiring connection and several other possible failures
 - weather conditions have hampered repair efforts, but Piatt is working with his contacts to make the necessary repairs
- The Bobcat utility vehicle failed again in mid-December, requiring pick-up and servicing by Best Line Equipment Rental
 - after inspection, it was determined that the vehicle's front axle had broken
 - to properly repair the vehicle, it was estimated that the cost would exceed \$5,000
 - Stoudt instructed the shop to do the minimum work required to restore the vehicle to working condition, but chose to not repair the axle (allowing 2-wheel but not 4-wheel drive)
 - the repair work cost \$1,167.51
 - the vehicle continues to function in a limited capacity, but Stoudt fears another, final, failure is inevitable
 - Stoudt anticipates the purchase of a replacement vehicle in early 2019 if DCED grant funding is approved



MANAGED SITES (continued)

Montour Preserve (continued)

- Stoudt discovered on 1/22 that the heat in the Environmental Education Center auditorium was not working properly
 - Stoudt and Piatt troubleshot the HVAC system on 1/23, but could only get the temperature in the room up to roughly 68°
 - With special events scheduled in the room on 1/23, 1/25, 1/27 and 1/28, Stoudt chose to purchase two electric space heaters (at a total cost of \$494) to supplement the room's HVAC system
 - Stoudt anticipates the total replacement of the building's HVAC system in 2019 if DCED grant funding is approved
- Stoudt, Piatt, Beam, Yeich and several volunteers (Deb Steransky, Ken Mertz, Jeff Foster, Randy Watts, George Ritter and Brett Boush) worked on 1/17 to cut and stack firewood for the sugar shack
- MARC anticipates the repair of cracks in several of the visitors' center roof joists in early 2019 if DCED grant funding is approved
- o 2019 Maple Sugaring Open House dates have been set:
 - Sunday, March 3, from 12:00pm 4:00pm
 - Saturday, March 9, from 9:30am 2:30pm
- o The Pennsylvania Master Naturalist program volunteers will be hosting a pancake breakfast fundraiser at the Montour Preserve on Saturday, March 9, from 8:30am 11:00am

 - Stoudt will incorporate several best-practice suggestions into MARC's operations and will work with MARC's Development Advisory Committee to attempt to implement several fundraising recommendations

 - o roughly sixty supporters attended the event
 - o MARC recognized Mike Mills and Frank Dombroski for 10+ years of service on MARC's Board
