NEW BUSINESS

SEASONAL MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN HIRE

Stoudt reported that MARC received two applications for the proposed Seasonal Maintenance Technician hire from Doug Fought and Craig Reinard. Stoudt reported that both candidates were very well-suited to the position, but both had scheduling challenges that may prevent them from working the number of hours each week that MARC had hoped. Stoudt requested approval to hire both candidates as Seasonal Maintenance Technicians at a rate of 17/hour, with the understanding that the combined hours worked by the two individuals would total the average 10-15 hours/week as planned.
