US DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE WILDLIFE SERVICES AGREEMENT RENEWAL

Stoudt requested approval to renew the annual wildlife services agreement with the US Department of Agriculture's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service for the control of Canada Geese at the Montour Preserve, as presented on pages 29-33 of the meeting agenda packet. Stoudt noted the full \$4,478.03 total fee would be paid only if MARC requested all services in the agreement; Stoudt anticipates the actual fee will be less, per MARC's past experience.
